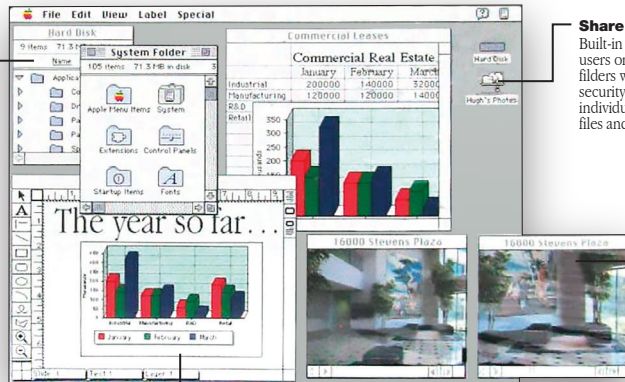
Run multiple applications.
